Every day you will be 'learning through play'. Mrs Catherall will teach you new skills and create fun activities for you to complete in the different classroom areas .




Maths Area:

Over the holidays it would be good to practice writing your name and going over the sounds in your name. Maybe you could begin to learn other sounds in the alphabet too.





