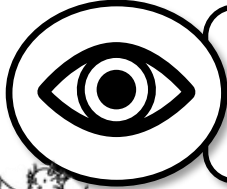




Classroom Non-Negotiables

Each class has a *Helpwr Heddiw* system or equivalent to encourage pupil leadership in Welsh.

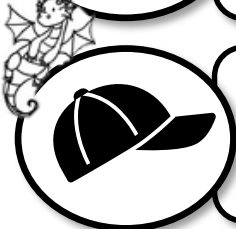


Welsh

Every class holds a weekly *Welsh Wednesday* session where pupils play Welsh games, use a graffiti board to write in Welsh, and enjoy using the language creatively.



Classes take part in regular Welsh reading sessions and develop fluency and alphabet recognition.



Each class takes home a Welsh mascot or *Cap Cymraeg* each week, sharing how they have used Welsh.



Digital tools, including Microsoft, Google, Adobe Express, J2Launch, Blooket, Kahoot, and Magi Ann Apps, are used to develop Welsh reading, writing, and speaking.



Enrichment

Every class contributes to whole-school Welsh events (e.g. Eisteddfod, Dydd Miwsig Cymru, Shwmae Day).
